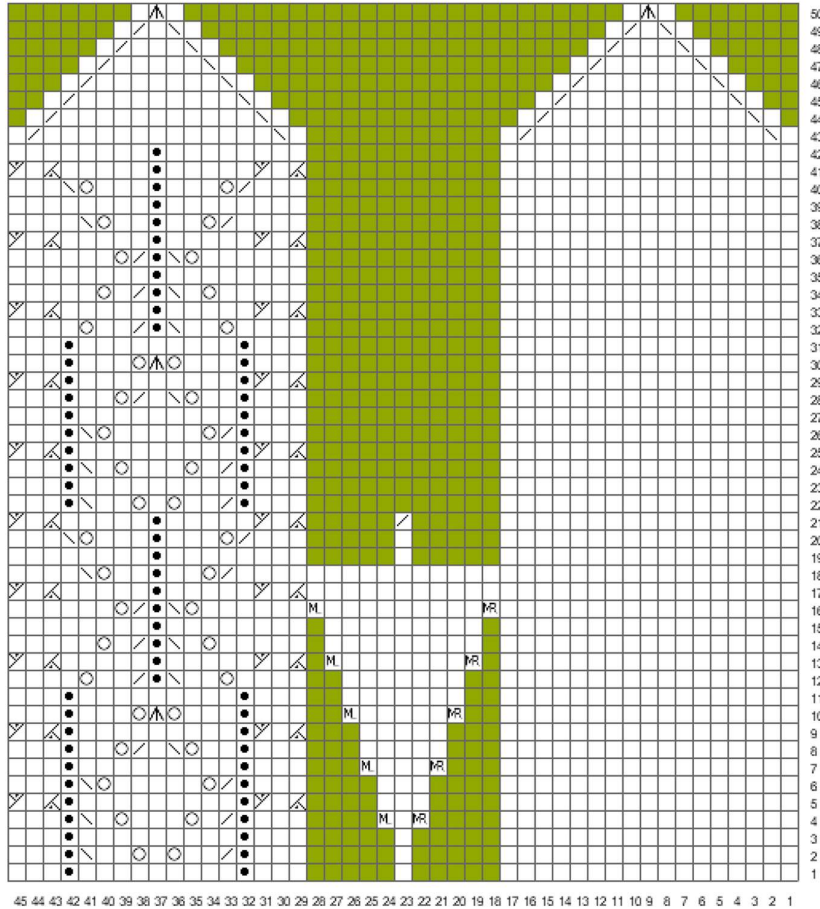




Anna Olava

Mittens

Chart left mitten:



Size:	Female
Yarn suggestion:	1 strand HS Peruvian and 1 strand HS Silk Mohair
Yarn:	Ca. 20 g HS Silk Mohair and 70 g HS Peruvian
Needle size:	4 and 4,5 mm
Gauge:	17/10

Pattern:

Cast on 30 stitches with one strand of Peruvian wool and 1 strand of ilk mohair on needle size 4 mm using the Italian cast on method.

Knit ribbing, knit 1, purl 1 until your work measures 12 cm. If you prefer a twisted rib knit 1 twisted stitch and purl 1.

Change to needle size 4.5 mm and knit one round while evenly increasing with 5 stitches. You now have 35 stitches in total.

Knit pattern according to the chart. Increase for thumb gusset according to chart.

Thumb gusset:

Place a stitch marker on each side of the first stitch of the round. This marks the thumb stitch.

Increase on every third round by M1R before first stitch marker, knit 1 and M1L after second stitch marker. Continue until you have 11 stitches between the stitch markers. All increased stitches are a knit stitch. Refer to chart.

When you have 11 stitches for the thumb gusset leave the increased stitches to rest on a separate cable. Cast on 1 stitch at gusset and continue to knit in the round according to the chart.

Thumb:

Place the stitches from separate cable back on the needles. Pick up 1 stitch in the stitch you cast on in addition to one stitch on each side. Knit these stitches together with a stitch from the thumb to prevent a hole in your gusset. Thumb = 12 stitches.

Knit 12 rounds stockinette. Knit 2 together throughout the next round. Cut yarn and pull thread through the remaining stitches. Fasten all loose ends.

Don't forget to knit right and left mitten! 😊
