


Runde

Hat & fingerless mittens



Size:	Women
Yarn:	1 strand Soft Sock and 1 strand Silk Mohair held together, or other similar yarn (425m/100gr & 420m/50gr)
Meterage:	12 gr Silk Mohair and 15 gr Soft Sock for the fingerless mittens, 25 gr Silk Mohair and 50 gr Soft Sock for the hat
Needlesize:	3,5mm
Gauge:	24/10

Pattern:



- 🗌 = Knit
- = Slip stitch
- = Purl



This pattern is named after the bird island Runde which is located near where I grew up, Herøy.

Pattern for fingerless mittens:

Loosely cast on 40 sts. K according to the pattern for 10cm.

Thumb gusset:


Place a stitch marker on each side of the 3 first sts.Stitch 1,2 and 3 from the pattern, these will now become your thumb gusset sts. Continue knitting stockinette stitch on all but the middle st on the thumb sts, this will continue with the pattern. Continue knitting according to pattern on the hand sts

K three rnds M1R knit to the stitch marker M1L, knit to end of round

Continue k *-* until you have 17 sts for the thumb gusset

Place the 17 sts on hold and cast on 3 new sts, continue knitting according to pattern for 5 cm $\,$

Cast off with an i-cord like this: Knit 3 sts all in the first st, put the 3 sts back on the left needle. *K2, K2tog through the back loop, place the 3 sts back on the left needle* Rpt *-* to end of round.



Thumb:

Place the 17 sts on your needles and pick up the 3 sts you cast on alongside with 1 st on each side of the three sts. These 2 extra sts you K2tog with

another st to avoid getting holes.

K 4 rnds, cast off with i-cord

Pick up 40 sts at the cuff, cast off with i-cord

Mittens:

If you rather want to knit mittens, knit the part after the thumb gusset until it covers the pinky

Decrease and cast off like this: Place the sts on two needles, with 20sts on each needle.

- K1, ssk. K according to pattern till 3 sts remain on the needle, k2tog, k1
- Do the same on the second needle.

Do this every other rnd until 6 sts remain (3 on each needle). Cut yarn and pull the yarn through the remaining sts.

Hat:

Cast on 120 sts, K according to pattern for 6 cm, K 3 rnds stockinette, on the next rnd evenly dec 4 sts, continue with stockinette st until it measures 6 cm

Turn your work.

Knit according to pattern with only 116 sts until the pattern measures 15cm.

Decrease and cast off like this:

Lift two sts off the needle together as if to knit, k1, lift the two sts over the knitted st (2 sts dec), p 1

Rpt *-* to end of rnd.

K1, p1 4 rnds

Ssk to end of rnd

K3 rnds

K2tog to end of rnd

Cut yarn and pull the yarn through the remaining sts

Pick up 120 sts on the cast on edge and cast off with i-cord. Fold the edge up and steam it so that it stays in place.





Abbrevations:

K = Knit	P = Purl
Rnd(s) = Round(s)	Dec = Decrease(d)
St(s) = Stitch(es)	Rpt = Repeat
M1R = Make 1 Right	M1L = Make 1 left
Ssk = Slip, slip, knit together	K2tog = Knit 2 sts
